How to Record Phone Calls with ACR While using Google Voice is simple and straightforward, it lacks some of the features many users want, such as: B. Automatically record calls as soon as they are initiated. That's where ACR comes in: not only does it have more options, but it also doesn't alert both users that they're recording. So if you want to secretly record a phone call, this is the tool you need. There are two versions of this app: free and premium. The latter removes all ads from the app and adds some useful features, e.g. B. the ability to record with a contact, start recording in the middle of a conversation, save recordings to Dropbox or Google Drive and much more. However, as always, I recommend trying the free version first to see if it meets your needs. Let's start with that. Once you start ACR, you must accept the terms - vsapplications, but it is legitimate. After accepting the terms of the application, you must grant it all the necessary access rights: contacts, microphone, phone and storage. Limitations of Android Recording Google has never been a big fan of Android call recording apps, at least not the third-party ones. In Android 9, the company added restrictions that prevented many apps from recording phone calls. Apps seemed to run, but only silence or ending could be heard when playing the song. Conversation. In Android 10, Google further restricted these types of apps by blocking microphone call recording. In response, many app developers have started using the Android accessibility service to record phone calls. However, Google updated its developer guidelines in April 2022 to state that it does not allow apps on the Play Store to use its accessibility service to record calls. These rules went into effect on May 11, 2022. The company went so far as to label the call recording as spyware. Behavior that can be considered spying on a user can also be labeled as spyware. Google stated this in its developer guidelines. "For example, recording audio or phone calls, or stealing app data." In the past, users could bypass Google's lock by changing the audio source or format, turning up the speaker volume as high as possible, automatically recording instead, or even rooting their phones. Since then, others have started downloading call recording apps through an APK file instead of downloading them directly from Google Play. In all this, the version of Android installed on the phone also depends. Apps for devices running Android 9 and below should still be able to record phone calls without being subject to Google's latest restrictions. However, apps on phones running Android 10 or later that attempt to use the accessibility service may be violating Google's new guidelines. The legality issue Assuming you find a working call recording app, can you legally record a call, especially if you don't ask the other person for permission? The answer depends on where you live. US federal and most state laws allow phone recording if only one party consents (yes, it could be you). However, some states require both parties to consent to the recording. Of course, other countries have their own laws. For full legal protection, ask the other person to do sobefore recording the call. Considering all such limitations, limitations and obstacles, here are some apps that might be able to record Android phone calls one way or another. Google Phone The Google Phone app (opens in a new window) offers built-in call recording, but with several strings attached. The app must be preinstalled on your phone with the latest update. You must have Android 9 or higher. And most importantly, it needs to be supported by your region, carrier, and device, which puts many phones and locations out of service. Make sure your phone is using the Phone by Google app and not the Samsung Phone app, for example. Once you have the right app, open it, tap the three dots icon in the top right corner and select Settings. Tap Call Recording to configure the types of calls you want to record. If you don't see the call recording option, your phone can't record calls through the app. If you have the option to record calls, tap the Record button on the next call you want to record. When you're done, click the Stop Recording button. You can access the recording in the Record section of the Phone app. Tap the recorded caller's name, select the recording from the call log, and then tap Play. Google Voice With Google Voice (opens in a new window) you choose your own phone number, which is used to route incoming calls to your mobile phone. After setting up your phone number and Google Voice account, tap the app's hamburger icon in the top left. Tap Settings and turn on the Incoming call options switch to enable call recording. The limitation is that you can only record incoming calls. When you answer the call, press number 4 on the keyboard to record the call. The message says the call will be recorded, so make sure you have the other person's consent beforehand. To stop recording, press 4 on the keyboard again. Automatic Call Recording Automatic Call Recording (opens in a new window) is a simple yet powerful recording application. Open the app and grant the necessary permissions to record audio, access contacts, make and manage calls, and access photos and other media. The app will then warn you that due to new Google Play restrictions, future versions downloaded from the store may no longer record calls on this device. On devices running Android 10 or later, you need to enable the accessibility service. Touch the power button. On the Accessibility settings screen, under Downloaded apps, tap Call Recording and turn on the Use call recording toggle. Allow the app full control of the device, i.e. H. can view and control the screen, and view and perform certain actions. Then return to the program. Before you can record anything, you need to set up the app in the Settings menu. Here you can enable or disable automatic recording of incoming and outgoing calls. You can also record only certain contacts. Be sure to turn up the volume in the recording area and turn on the recording volume. It is also possible to enable recording when shaking the phone. If you leave automatic recording enabled by default, it will start recording every time you make or receive a call. You can then open the app to view the recording. From the options screen, you can save the call as an audio file on your phone, add notes about the call, delete the recording, or share it via email or social media. The free version comes with ads, but the \$8.49 Pro version (opens in a new window) removes ads and offers other features. During testing, Automatic Call Recorder worked immediately on a device running Android 9. When testing on Android 12, the app had to enable the accessibility service to record calls. Call Recorder - Automatic Call Recorder ProCall Recorder - Automatic Call Recorder in a new window) is a robust application with many options. First, it will guide you through the required setup steps such as: B. Enabling accessibility settings. You can then go to the settings screen and record calls automatically or manually, change the audio source and format, change the sound quality, increase the volume or turn on the option to start recording when you shake the phone. If you set the app to automatic mode, it will record incoming and outgoing calls from start to finish. Tap a recording while it's on the screen to listen to it in the app. On the recording screen, you can play the file, save it to your phone, send it via email or other services, and delete the recording. The app is free and supports ads, but you can pay \$3.49 to remove ads. When tested, Call Recorder - Automatic Call Recorder Pro successfully recorded phone calls on Android 9 and Android 12 devices with accessibility service. The app doesn't mention the latest accessibility service restrictions on Google Play, but future versions may not be able to record calls due to Google's new policies. Call Recorder - Cube ACRCall Recorder - Cube ACR (opens in a new window) is a more advanced premium application. The basic version is free, but displays ads and does not offer cloud backup of your recordings. If you want more features, a subscription costs \$6.99 for six months or \$9.99 for a full year after a free one-week trial. However, the free version should be able to do the job. As with other call recording apps, you need to grant Cube ACR permission to use the accessibility service on Android 10 or later. In the application settings, you can enable or disable automatic recording, exclude calls from unknown numbers, change the clarity and volume of calls, and enable recording of VoIP applications if your phone supports it. You can even geotag your recordings and pinpoint the caller's location. To record an outgoing call, simply call the other party as usual if you choose automatic recording, incoming calls are automatically recorded in the background. After the call, open the app to view and play the recordings. You can mark recordings as important, delete them, view the caller's location on a map, and share them via email or social networks. During testing, the Cube ACR recorded phone calls on Android 9 and Android 12 devices using the accessibility service. The application did not mention the restriction of access to the Google Play service. But as with other call recording apps, there may be problems with call recording in the future version due to changes in Google's policies.
